INTRODUCTION

Language is closely related to how people communicate with each other and to express a wide range of emotions, ideas, concepts, and actions of human in daily life. Therefore, some of the languages spread over the world and one of the languages that has spread over the world is English and it developed to become a trend because most people are interested in learning another language. In Linguistics, it is known as sociolinguistics.

According to Holmes (2013, p.1) Sociolinguistics is “a study of human and social learning”. In sociolinguistics, it is found there is a phenomenon of language that called bilingual and multilingual. Actually the concept of bilingualism or multilingualism is the same. According to Wardaugh, R., & Fuller, J. M. (2015, p. 85) states that “bilingualism and multilingualism individuals are more often usually forced to decide on a selected specific code whenever they select to speak and that they arrange to switch from code to code”.

Code-switching is the phenomenon when there are two or more languages that exist in the community and speaker frequently switch from one language to another language. We often see the use of code switching in everyday communication, such as when talking with friends, at work, school

and family, But this phenomenon does not only occur in school or work environments, but is also often found on social media such as Facebook, WhatsApp, Twitter, TikTok and Instagram (Kamariah & Ambalegin (2019).

Apart from everyday communication, code switching is also often used in social media communication, one of which is Instagram. This happens because of the differences in each person's language, so sometimes to convey a message requires switching to another language so that communication can be established easily, and can be understood by the recipient of the message.

The use of code switching is influenced by many factors, one of which is globalization, this makes the number of language speakers who master more than one language increase significantly, this shows that Bilingualism or multilingualism is increasingly widespread, Bilingualism also occurs in the younger generation or children in adolescence. Code-Switching' can occur because language is one of the most important forms of human behaviour symbol and an important component of a group's identity. Code switching is not just a phenomenon in a society where every member uses more than one language, but also a necessity in that society. Code switching is used to transfer the meaning to the interlocutor. When

the language used by a speaker in conveying a meaning or message cannot be understood by interlocutor, then the speaker needs to change the language used in another language that can be understood by the recipient of the message or interlocutor

In this study, researchers are interested to analyses the using of code switching used by Instagram users and some factors cause code switching on instagram. The data in this study will be taken from several posts, comments, and conversations conducted by Instagram users. This research is expected to be useful in the process of learning language, especially studies of sociolinguistic and the using of language. Therefore in this research, researcher decided to choose code switching as a topic of discussion because the author realizes the importance of using code switching in bilingual or multilingual communication.

B. Literature review

Sociolinguistics

According to Chaer & Agustina (2014), Sociolinguistics is study the relationship between language and society. It is interested in explaining why we speak differently in different social contexts, and sociolinguistics concerned with identifying the social functions of language and the ways it is used to convey social meaning. Sociolinguistics is that part of linguistics which is concerned with language as a social and cultural phenomenon. Code refers to a language or a variety of language , It is a system that is used by people to communicate with each other. When people want to talk each other, they have to choose a particular code to express their is a symbol of nationalism that is used by people to speak or communicate in a particular language for different purposes of communication (both spoken or written).code is dividen by 2 and one of them is code switching .

Code switching in a bilingual (or multilingual) community forces people to be able to speak or communicate in at least two different languages. Code switching is switching the situation from one code to another. If a speaker firstly uses code A (language) then she/he changes the code to code B (other language), Language can be a barrier to someone to communicate or it can be a way of success in life. Someone

who cannot interact to other by using the target language, of course, will be difficult to adapt later on. Meanwhile, for those who are able to speak the target language will have good relation to others (Mubarak, 2019).

Bilingualism

Bilingualism is an ability of the speaker language in using two linguistically perfect, with coverage of language skills comprehensive, namely writing, reading, speaking, and listening. A speaker is said to have Bilingual ability if both language skills are almost the same good with first language skills, bilingualism is the way a person uses two languages to socialize with people from abroad and within the country who have different languages. one's skills using two languages in English is “*bilinguality*”.

Bilingual children have the ability to speak in both languages at different levels. While speaking a language, being fed by another language is an important process for bilingual language development. When two languages are spoken, reasoning and concept formation are better developed and advanced language skills such as code switching, accents, and syntax are obtained (Doron, 2014). At the end of age 3, the average bilingual children use two words for most

concepts, thus gaining more experience of switching between languages (Crivello et al., 2016). and also according According to Rahardi (2015) Bilingualisme is understanding two things language or more, not only language is attached but culture is also involved stuck in it.

C. Research methodology

This research is descriptive research because this study aims to describe and look for the factor of the use of code switching in Instagram, In this study the researchers used a sociolinguistics study to analysis the code switching in Instagram the data in this study will be taken from several posts, comments, and conversations made by Instagram user.

According to manjunatha (2019) Descriptive research can be explained as a statement of affairs as they are at present with the researcher having no control over variable. Moreover, “descriptive studies may be characterised as simply the attempt to determine, describe or identify what is, while analytical research attempts to establish why it is that way or how it came to be” Descriptive research is “aimed at casting light on current issues or problems through a process of data collection that enables them to describe the situation more completely than was possible

without employing this method.”In its essence, descriptive studies are used to describe various aspects of the phenomenon. In its popular format, descriptive research is used to describe characteristics or behavior.

D. Finding and Discussion

Researcher discusses the finding and divides them into three sections, the first part is about the types of code switching that occurs in Instagram interaction and the second part is about the factor of code switching and last is reason of using code switching

The Type of code Switching:

People must select a particular code whenever they choose to speak, and they may also decide to switch from that code to another or to mix codes even within sometimes very short utterances (Wardaugh, 2015).

- Tag Switching

According to (Stockwell, 2017) Tag switching is the simple form of code switching because in this form the speaker tags and certain set phrases or words in one language are inserted into an utterance otherwise in another. Tag switching often happens caused of the lacked if vocabulary.

The Factor of Code Switching:

According to Chaer and Agustina (2014), the cause of code switching is caused by due to speaker or speaker factors, interlocutors factors, the presence of people third, factors changing informal to formal or vice versa, and factors change the topic of conversations as will be explained below.

- speaker

in conversation, a speaker usually changes his language to meet the demands of the situation and creates an appropriate situation, and an important situation to gain an advantage. In a conversation, a person often changes his language with the aim that the other person can understand, and can create a comfortable, effective and profitable situation.

- listeners

the listener can cause code switching, the speaker has to change the language because he has to adapt

and he also needs language skills that are equivalent to the speaker.

- the presence of a third person or a change in situation

the speaker changes language because a third person comes and participates in their conversation. Therefore, code switching occurs which aims to adapt the language to the person you are talking to

- change from formal to informal

the interlocutor changes language when they realize that using another language will make it easier for them to express their ideas and feeling

E. Conclusion

Language is a crucial communication tool for humans, and in many communities, bilingual or multilingual individuals often switch between languages to convey meaning. This phenomenon, known as codeswitching, is not only a necessity in a society with multiple languages but also a way to convey meaning to the recipient.
